

Counselor and Staff Supplies Needed at Camp

Suggested items for YOU to bring to camp for your unit/center:

- Cooler for lunches or girls can use lunch line
- Water cooler filled with water-use for drinking
- Old tablecloth, plastic, or newspaper – to cover tables
- Hand wash jug, including soap
- Lawn chair for your relaxation
- Unit Bulletin board –paper, cardboard, etc.
- Unit Kaper Chart –paper, cardboard, etc.
- Matches
- Firewood/charcoal tongs
- Fire starters
- Ice cream making containers-make during cookout
- Hot pads for cooking
- Storybook or games for camper down time.
- Ice for coolers and drinks
- Rope for lunch line or drip line; also may use a length of twine supplied by camp-at office.
- Water buckets or carrying containers
- Wagon to haul equipment to your unit site
- If needed – cooking tongs, can opener, salt & pepper, hot pads, special cooking items
- Sprinkle can for fire
- Charcoal starter chimney can
- Containers for mixing lemonade drinks at cookout
- Liquid dish soap – need a small amount for dishes (may also be in camp office)
- Clorox - need a small amount for dishes (may also be in camp office)

GSCNC Equipment Box

The Girl Scout Council equipment box is located behind the Camp Office, or Amphitheater Pavilion. The equipment checkout person will be at the shed Monday and Tuesday. A paper must be filled out and signed by the Unit counselor to check out equipment. The checkout sheet is found at the shed when open, or in your unit folder. The check-in time will be Wednesday to Friday at the shed. The equipment paper must accompany the equipment to the shed and all equipment must be clean. Girls may return equipment, if all paperwork is in order and pieces are clean. Do not drop off equipment in or near the box, as it could walk away.
